Clinic of HOPE

- As per our usual policy, the Clinic of HOPE helps patients with chronic conditions; non-emergency. The Clinic of HOPE does not treat colds, test for the flu or COVID-19.
- We are working on rapidly deploying a telemedicine service allowing Dr. Ballard to see patients virtually.
- We follow all CDC recommendations to prevent the transmission of all communicable diseases.

Manna Pantry & Fresh Produce Out Reach

- Beginning Monday March 23rd our pantry will convert to a drive -thru. model.
- Clients will call inside and sign-up for food by phone.
- We will pack their groceries, deliver them to the curb, and clients will groceries put in their car.
- If clients need help putting groceries in their car, we will provide assistance.
